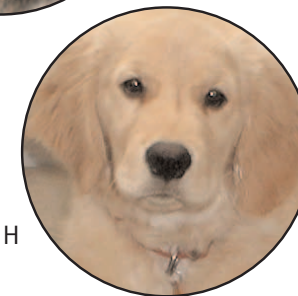
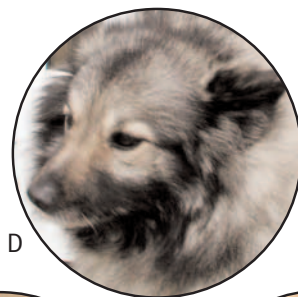
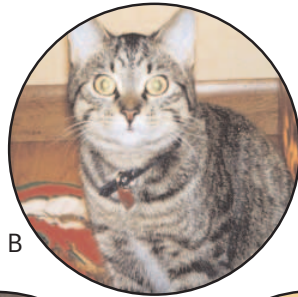

In March, Robert L. Peters chaired North America’s first Icograda Regional Meeting in Vancouver, wearing his hat as Icograda President. 35 delegates from ten countries, five US states, and four Canadian provinces met to share experiences regarding the state of the visual communication profession. All attending the meetings agreed that raising the awareness of the importance of internationalism for North American designers is a key by which to bring about positive change, find solutions to common challenges, and help close gaps between cultures worldwide. Following the Icograda Regional Meeting, more than 200 participants attended the Icograda Design Perspectives symposium at Emily Carr College of Art and Design. The event, entitled “Environs’002: Design Without Borders”, was jointly organized by GDC, AIGA, and Icograda.
